

Alvin is also taking up Computer studies; both are enrolled at the Computer Dynamics School in Balibago, Angeles City, while the other one is the daughter of Genoveva de Guzman taking up Engineering at the Holy Angel University. It would be interesting to note that our Batchmate Enrique Calaguas is presently recuperating from his upper respiratory disease, an ailment common to tri-cycle drivers, as day-in and day-out, they are exposed to the elements of nature.

The selection of who shall be assisted by our Association was done thru a Special Committee that was tasked to evaluate who among our Batchmates are really in dire need. They were personally visited by the committee together with our Energetic Vice President & Chairperson Ninfa Agapito Ong. The Special Committee considered the following criteria in the selection of who among the Batchmates are eligible for the educational assistance, viz:

- Batchmate has no permanent source of income or his/her earnings is not sufficient to sustain his/her family's cost of living and education of his/her children;
- Batchmate's size of family and dwellings;
- Batchmate has no family members or relatives that support them.

Our Batch will shoulder the enrollment and tuition fees of the qualified student while the allowance, transportation and incidental expenses are for the account of our Batchmate. The preferred courses as agreed upon during our Board Meeting will be limited to four (4) year courses or vocational courses and our Batch will be extending assistance only up to the time the student is not yet able to work.

Since we were rather late in the selection process, the Board was not able to have the qualified students enroll in four (4) year college courses, but instead have them enrolled in two (2) year computer courses, which they also preferred since they wanted to immediately land a job upon finishing their studies.

Thru your continued support we assure you our dear Batchmates that we can extend more assistance to our needy Batchmates. Aside from the educational assistance, we are also giving small donations for the bereaved families of our batchmates, medical assistance for those stricken with lingering illness, in the hope that in our own little way, the Forever Young '71 can show to their Batchmates that we care. That our theme "Pamiabe-abe, saup-saup, at pamicacalugud dareng Forever Young '71" is alive in us. And this can only be made possible thru your continued support of the ideals of our Association.

To all of you our Dear Batchmates, our warmest greetings and again thanking you for your trust and confidence in us.
